The Veterans Furniture Center

- Veteran Managed by an all-veteran volunteer Board of Directors.
- Volunteer Based -- veterans, active duty military, and other supporters -- obtain and deliver furniture, as well as to staff the office and warehouse.
- We deliver furniture to veterans every single week, fifty-two weeks a year.
- Since 2009 the VFC has provided furniture to over 2,400 veterans.
- We are currently assisting over 400 veterans a year.



Making a Difference

- The VFC plays an indispensable role in supporting the VA in its efforts to help homeless veterans.
- Although social service agencies can and do assist veterans in meeting their housing needs, they are often unable to provide furniture to their clients. By providing free furniture and household goods, we fill a "critical gap."
- When the VA places the formerly homeless veteran into subsidized housing, it puts a much-needed roof over their heads and gives them a clean and safe place to sleep at night.
- When the VFC delivers furniture, it turns that shelter into a home, a home the veteran can call their own.
- Our social service partners tell us that having furniture and basic household goods can make a significant difference in helping formerly homeless veterans stay sober and in keeping them off the streets.
